Whilst working on these shows I took many skills away including live casting which is as true to life as casting gets. I learnt the reality of working to schedules and following a designer and directors specification.

SCENIC ART CO-ORDINATOR: September - October 2022

For this role I was in charge of managing a team of scenic art assistants, scheduling paint calls around the production plan. Managing budget and being the sole communicator of the department to the creatives which taught me how to effectively communicate my points and ideas across.

WARDROBE MANAGER: October - December 2022

During this role I followed the costume design process from the white card meeting all the way to the final production, through fittings, tech and dress rehearsal, where I managed and maintain the shows running wardrobe. This taught me to keep organised and helped me to understand the performers position in relation to the work that I do.

A contact from Guildhall reached out as they are producing a show and they would like me to be the set and costume designer having been aware of my previous work and knowing I have keen interest in design. I will see this show through from the initial script, through rehearsals to the final show. In which I will design all the aspects of set and costumes, with the added challenge of working to a tight budget and the excitement of working alongside a composer and an orchestra to enhance the acoustics of the set and the space.
