GUILDHALL HARP DEPARTMENT NEWS: SUMMER 2024

In 2023 the Guildhall School was ranked number one in Arts, Drama and Music by the Complete University Guide, in the top ten performing arts institutions in the QS World University rankings, and we topped the Guardian University Guide league table for Music. We are now enjoying an exciting and stimulating 2024.

The year started with the Studio Orchestra playing the music of Burt Bacharach, using our Big Blue Camac electric harp. There were also lots of notes to play in a London Symphony Orchestra/Orchestral Artistry repertoire session with Nicolò Foron conducting Sibelius 1. This was a wonderful chance to perform with a professional conductor alongside members of the LSO; there was also a chance to sit in a professional rehearsal with the Orchestra.

The orchestral schedule is as busy as ever, with regular weekly repertoire sessions, and chances to perform in the Barbican Hall with the Guildhall Symphony Orchestra conducted by Roberto Gonzales-Monjas. Our orchestral classes with LSO Principal Harp Bryn Lewis prepare core orchestral repertoire with the students, and they take these skills into practical orchestral sessions, this year rehearsing/performing works by Berlioz, Prokofiev, Mahler, Britten, Strauss, Dvorak, Holst, Stravinsky, Ravel and Respighi.

Opera happens every term, and this year's Spring Opera includes harp and is the world première of a new work by Stephen McNeff 'A Star Next To The Moon'. In the Summer Term there are 3 new Operas with harp in our Opera Makers project.

Our regular Harp and Voice project is going from strength to strength, and this year 6 first-year composers will write pieces for harp and voice which will be showcased in the Summer Festival. We are passionate about the value of this project, where composers work intensively with a harpist and learn to love the instrument and write well for it.

We had a mesmerising class with **Hugh Webb** on The Glissando, and last term alumnus **Oliver Wass** gave a class on Ginastera's Harp Concerto, with which he won the Guildhall Gold Medal. We were so proud when Masters student **Heather Brooks** appeared in the Final of this year's Gold Medal, giving an outstanding concerto performance in the Barbican Hall, just weeks after appearing at the Wigmore Hall as part of the Wigmore Recital Prize recital. **Sioned Williams'** masterclass was a perfect balance of challenge and kindness, with all the performers energised and uplifted by her comments. We welcomed **Emily Hoile**, prizewinning soloist and Principal Harpist of the WDR Symphony Orchestra in Cologne, Germany, who gave a wonderful Masterclass in March.

In the Summer Term, our special guests are **Sandrine Chatron**, solo harpist of the Netherlands Philharmonic Orchestra and professor of harp at the Haute École de Musique, Geneva, who visited in May, and the inimitable **Park Stickney** who will join us for a Jazz workshop in our Summer Festival. We also hosted a workshop 'Harp Alchemy' with **Amy Turk** and **Lauren Scott**, who talked about how to forge your unique path as

a 21st-century musician as well as focusing on percussive and extended techniques for harp.

Finally – a happy and rare event to celebrate: two of our harp department Alumni, Oliver Wass and Lise Vandersmissen, are getting married in the summer! Maybe we should be called the Guildhall School of Music & Dating? We wish them every happiness.
